

HISTORY OF NSDWC

Action for Healthy Kids pioneered the Urban School Wellness Coalition (USWC) in 2013 to support school district leaders in implementing a whole child educational framework. Key decision makers from 33 of the country's largest school districts regularly convened as a community of practice to share information surrounding peer-approved best practices and to further advance urban school wellness.

In 2020, Action for Healthy Kids expanded the work of the Urban School Wellness Coalition significantly, to include new district members from urban and non-urban communities to provide a unique opportunity for district leaders to engage in a community of practice to learn best practices and share successes and challenges. This expanded coalition, the National School District Wellness Coalition, represents school districts nationwide and is working to translate the standards of the WSCC model into actionable and realistic policy, programs, and practices for Coalition members and all districts nationwide.
